

Outline of the Fiscal Year 2021 Business Plan

JSC plans to execute the following projects in FY 2022 to contribute to sanitation improvement in the Asia-Pacific region through its KnowledgeHub activities, under the APWF framework.

1. Networking

Collaboration with international organizations to create a network of sanitation-related organization in each country of the Asia-Pacific region.

2. Information gathering

Creation of a sanitation database for the Asia-Pacific region and execution of country surveys for sanitation improvement in each country.

To transfer sanitation knowledge and experience from developed countries such as Japan.
